As we review the investment summary figures for Q3, the global macroeconomic picture remains extremely weak, but especially so in Europe where the Eurozone economies are in total disarray, the Euro currency looks vulnerable and, at this point, all of the economic indicators are down. Last week one of my Partners asked a respected contact what they felt was the likelihood of a double-dip recession. The instant and certain response was that we are already in one! Whether or not this is true is up for debate, but few people operating in the financial services, manufacturing or retail sectors would argue.

Still, despite the parlous state of the economy, technology investment is one area that remains very active indeed. Investment levels in tech in the US reached a new high of \$7bn for the quarter, up over 25% on the previous record of \$5.6bn set last quarter. Levels in Europe also remained reasonably good – though never before has the gulf between the US and Europe been so large.

Exit markets remain challenging, and it will be interesting to see how Groupon's upcoming IPO is received. This process will have a major impact on sentiment in the markets and I am somewhat relieved that the revised targets for the IPO seem more realistic than they were a short while ago.

It feels like we are entering a pivotal quarter. When the next Index is produced in January 2012 we will all have a much better idea how the market is shaping up in the short-medium term. The apparent disconnect in the good times we see in the technology market and the rest of the economy, cannot last forever.

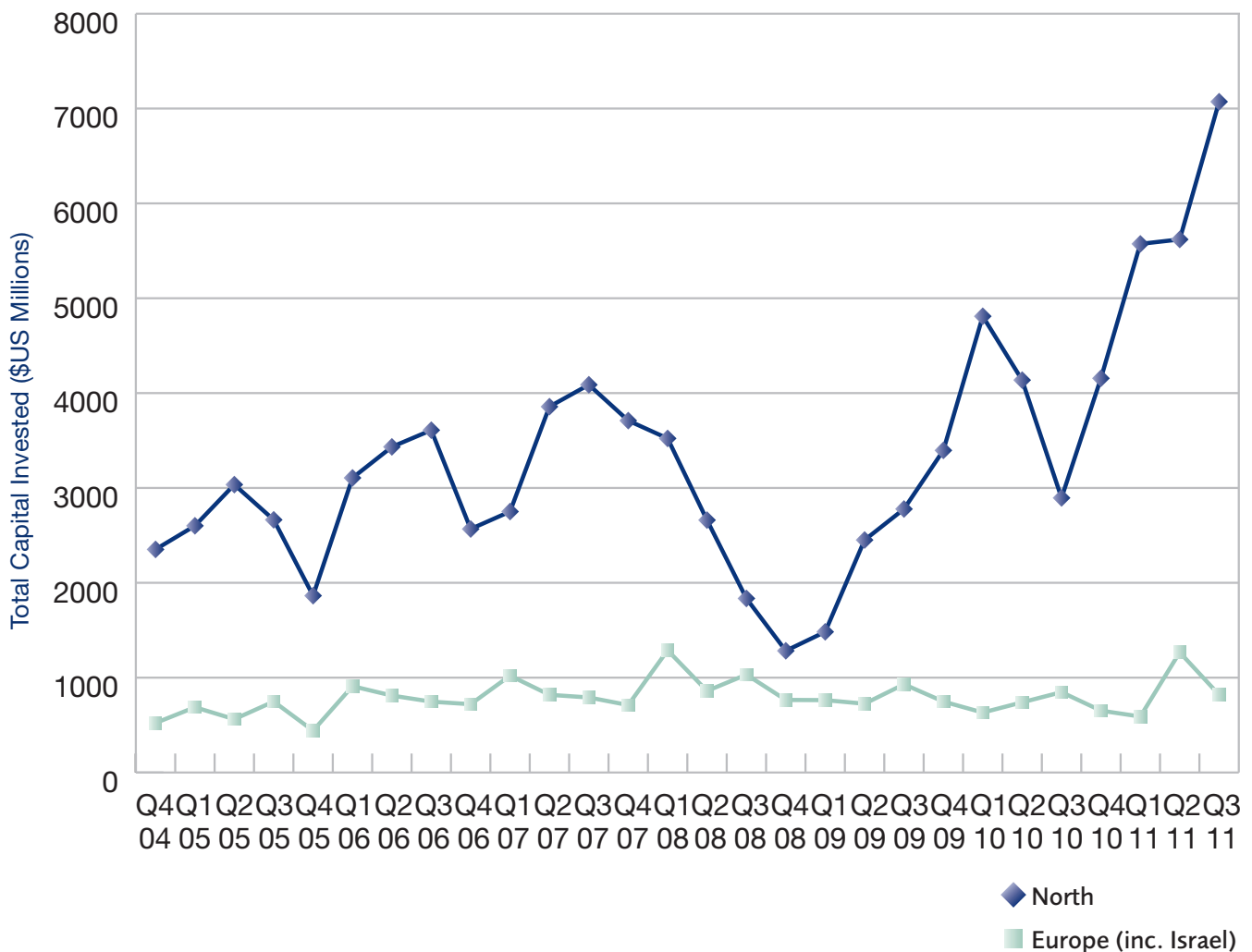

An incredible quarter in the US, way in excess of anything we have seen before, up 25% on the previous record quarter in Q2. There were 22 tech deals worth over \$50m with Twitter leading the way with an \$800m round led by DST. Airbnb, Tumblr, LightSquared and Opera Solutions all closed major funding rounds. It's interesting to see how buoyant the VC market remains and it is clear that a number of companies are being opportunistic as the availability of capital is so high currently. One cannot help but think we have seen it all before, but somehow, this time around, it feels different – much more grounded. Most of the VC backed companies we are working with have exponential revenue growth and this is despite, not because of, the market.

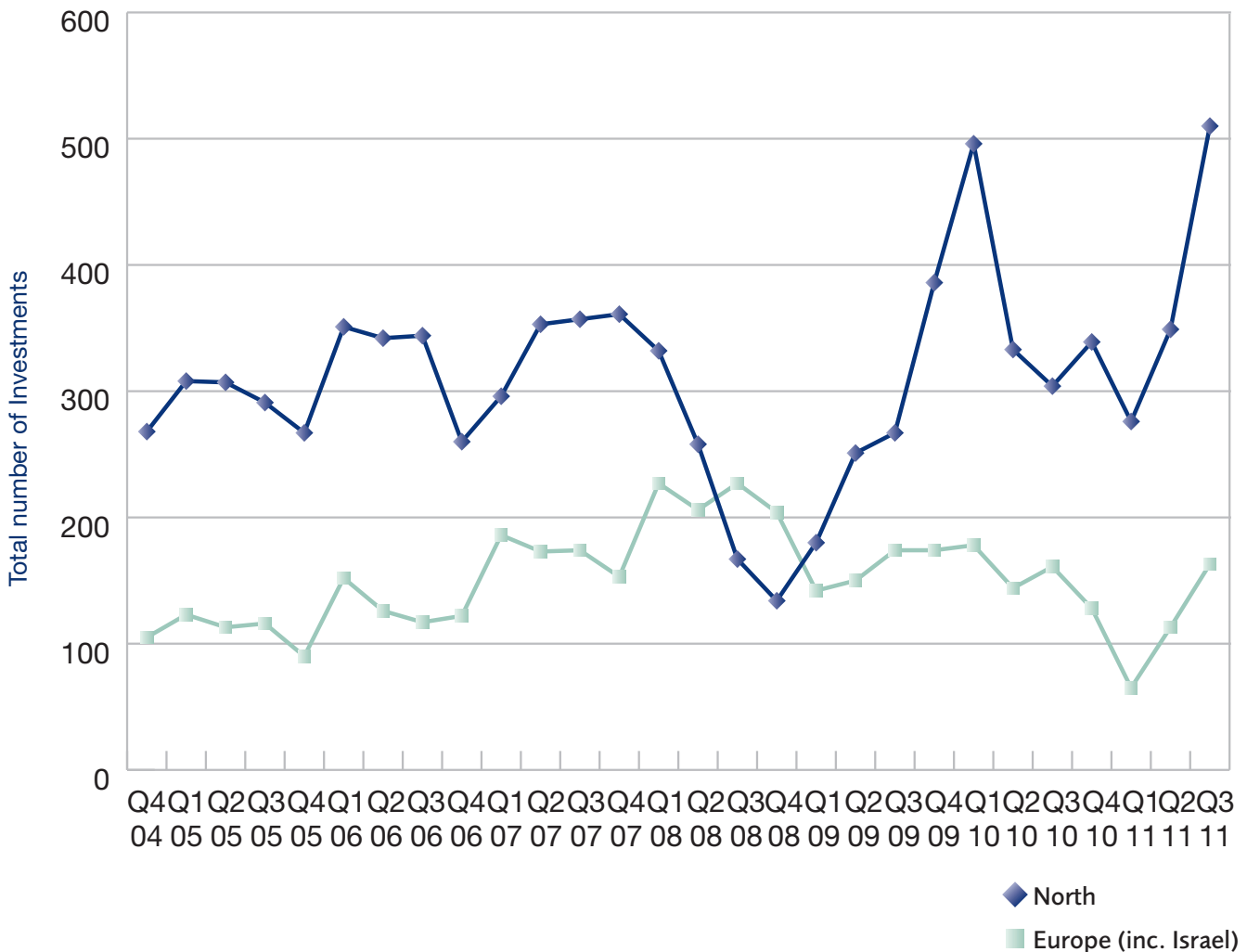

Q3 2011 has seen a massive increase in the number of deals in the US with 507 deals closed in the quarter. Again, this is a record for the Index, surpassing the previous high of 496 in Q1 2010. What is different this time around is the scale of investment with more, larger deals. Companies that might have resisted the urge to expand internationally have pushed the button, encouraged by the fertile market conditions and free availability of capital. It's still difficult to find \$1-2m in VC funding – it's much easier to get \$20m+.

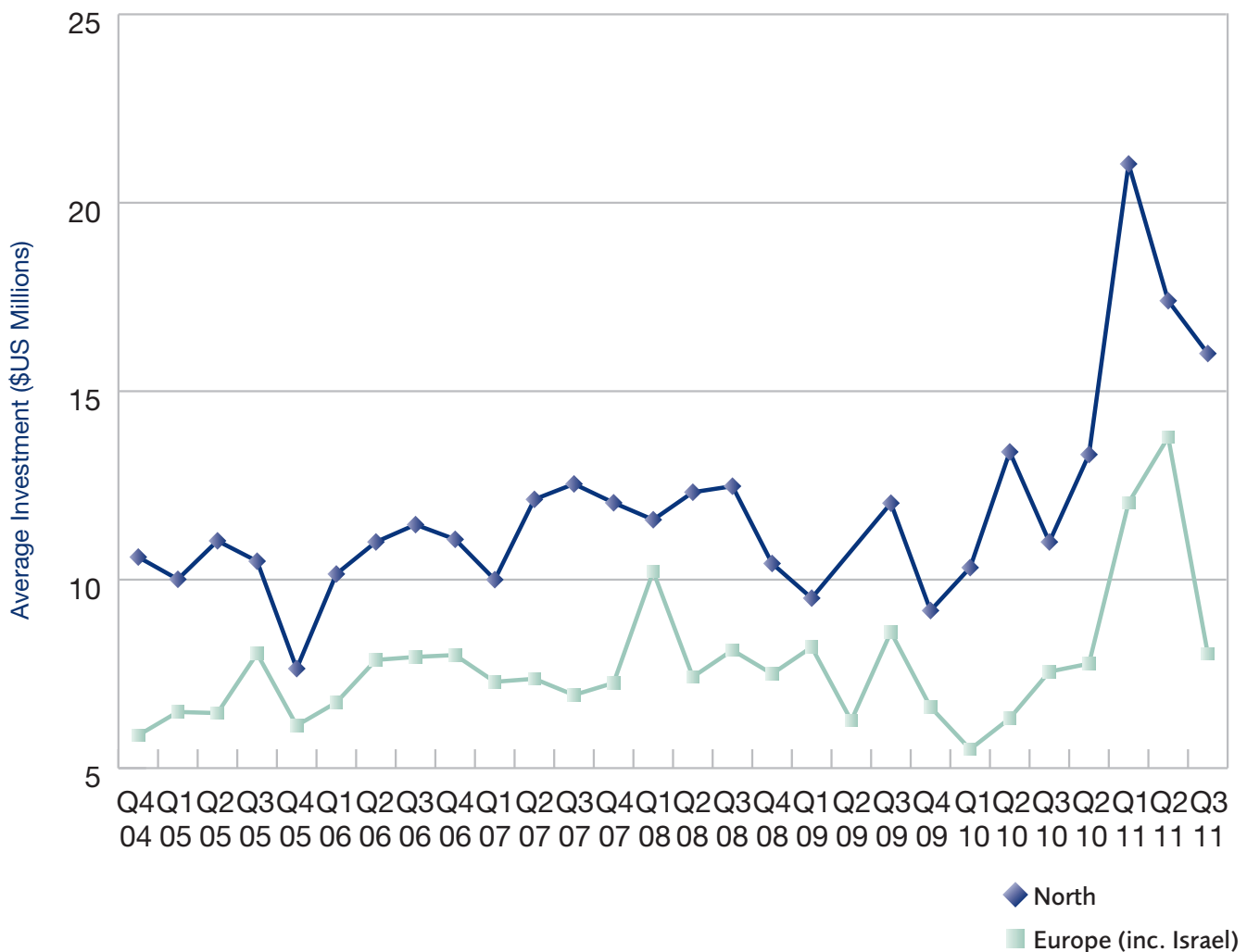

This quarter saw an average deal size of \$16m, some way off the highs of Q1 and Q2 - \$21m and \$17m respectively. It's interesting to note that Europe was down somewhat but this is largely due to the fact that there were no massive rounds such as the rounds closed by Spotify and Bigpoint earlier in the year. The market is still so small in Europe that these have a disproportionate impact upon the numbers when they happen.

It's great to see that all parts of the EMEA region, including Eastern and Southern Europe have been relatively active, producing some very interesting companies that are already having an impact on the world stage, such as Groupalia.
