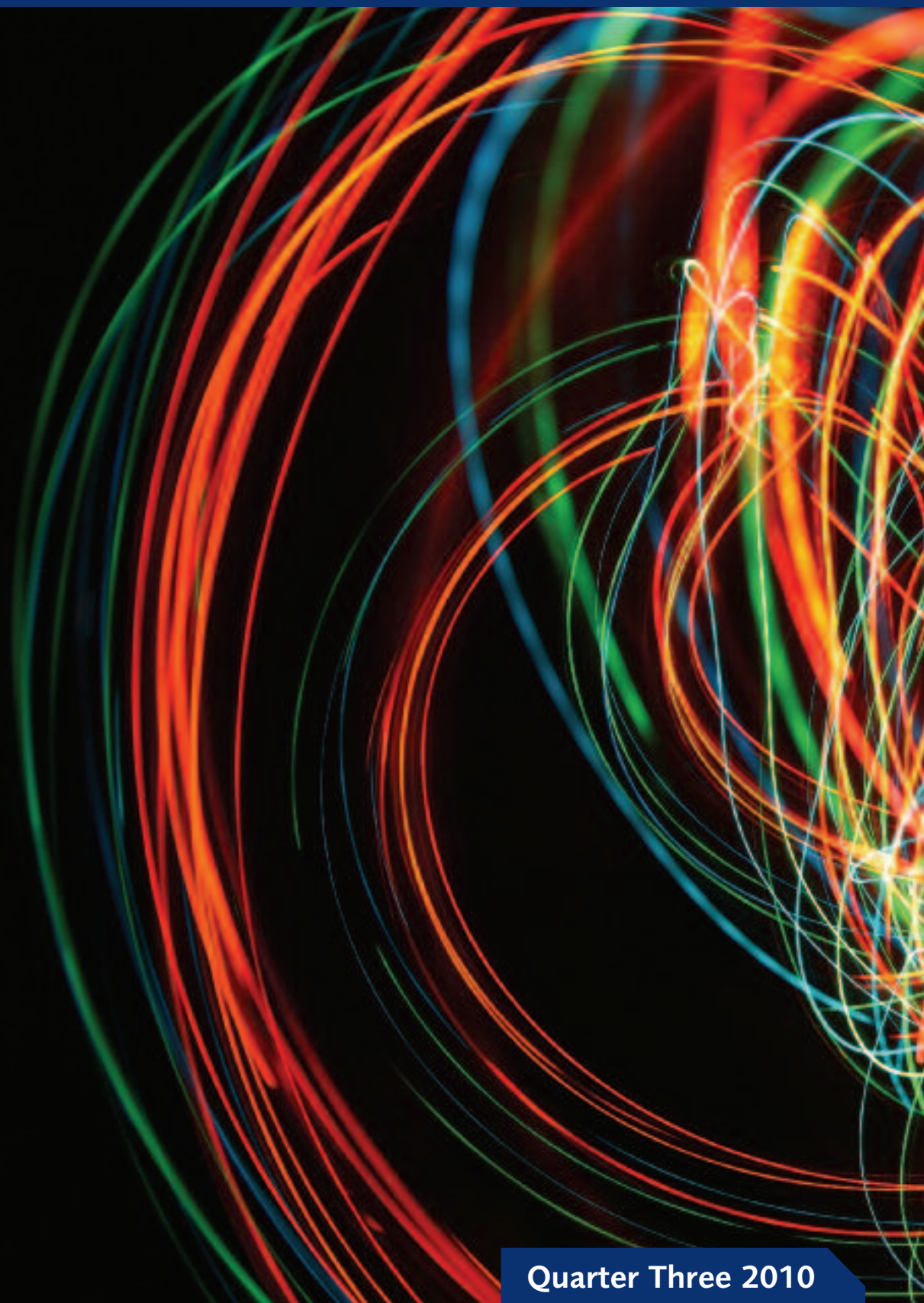

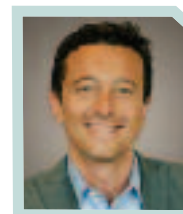

The doomsayers in the market will have us believe the tech venture business in Europe has hit the buffers, but the numbers do not reflect that. Sure, life is tough for some VCs that have not had an easy time raising new funds, but there is still money in ready supply for businesses that have a compelling proposition. There is real value out there and the current crop of early-stage tech businesses are the best there has ever been; driven in no small part by the tough fundraising environment dictating that they have had to manage their businesses very tightly and intelligently. Companies such as Wonga.com, Huddle.net, Spotify, Patersons, PKR, Moneybookers, Shazam and others have genuine \$billion exit potential.

It's an exciting time to be a part of the European tech scene and we are looking forward to continuing to help Europe's top entrepreneurs build businesses that really can challenge on the World-stage, rather than promise a lot and whimper out quietly with a 2x exit, leaving US investors to pick-up the real value in the deal.

The third quarter of 2010 in the US has seen a steep decline in both the value and quantity of investment in the technology space. One sector that is seemingly impervious to the sluggish overall investment is Cleantech. As the US, along with China, emerges as the key proponent of investment in this space, the companies based within these 'front runners of the Cleantech revolution' continue to prosper.

Despite the drop off in overall investment, this last quarter represents the best third quarter since 2007 and, when viewed in relation to other areas of the investment ecosystem, suggests consistency with a 'slow and steady recovery'. Specifically this relates to the M&A market, where venture backed companies continue to sell at record levels. Key to these successful sales are the people put in place to drive growth and revenue on behalf of investors, something that Calibre One has been doing for over ten years.

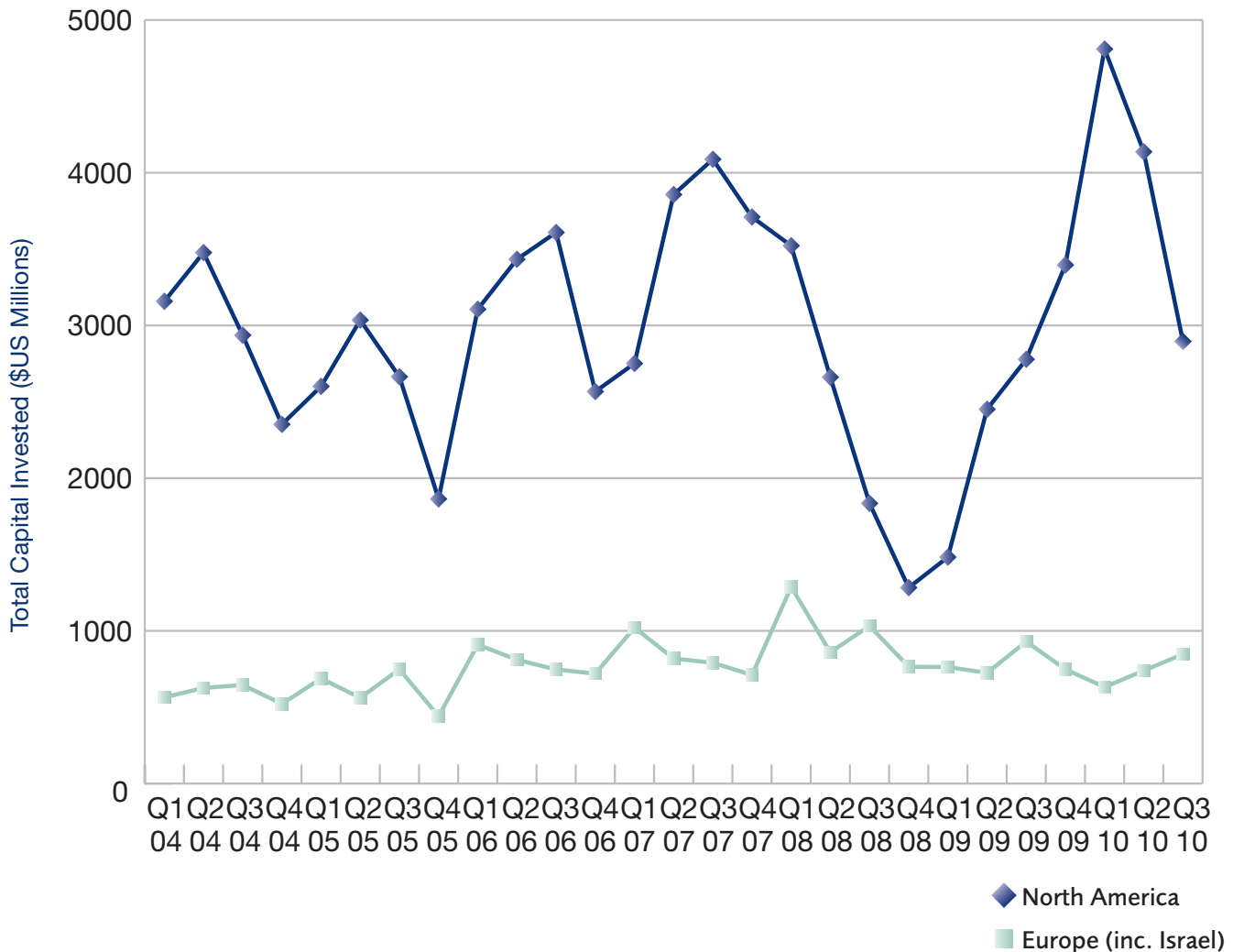

The real highlight for Q3 has to be in Europe, which has seen a steady improvement for the third quarter in succession. A 34% improvement from the start of the year suggests the so called ‘green shoots’ may be beginning to take hold. Furthermore, this growth has come despite the relatively poor performance of certain regions such as DACH, surely a blip following a particularly strong preceding quarter, and Ireland which marks a more concerted trend in mirroring the state of the wider Irish economy.

The value of investment into the US has decreased considerably from the previous three quarters, and while year on year comparison shows a 4% improvement, there is no hiding that while investors are willing to invest at the same frequency, the value of these investments is significantly lower.

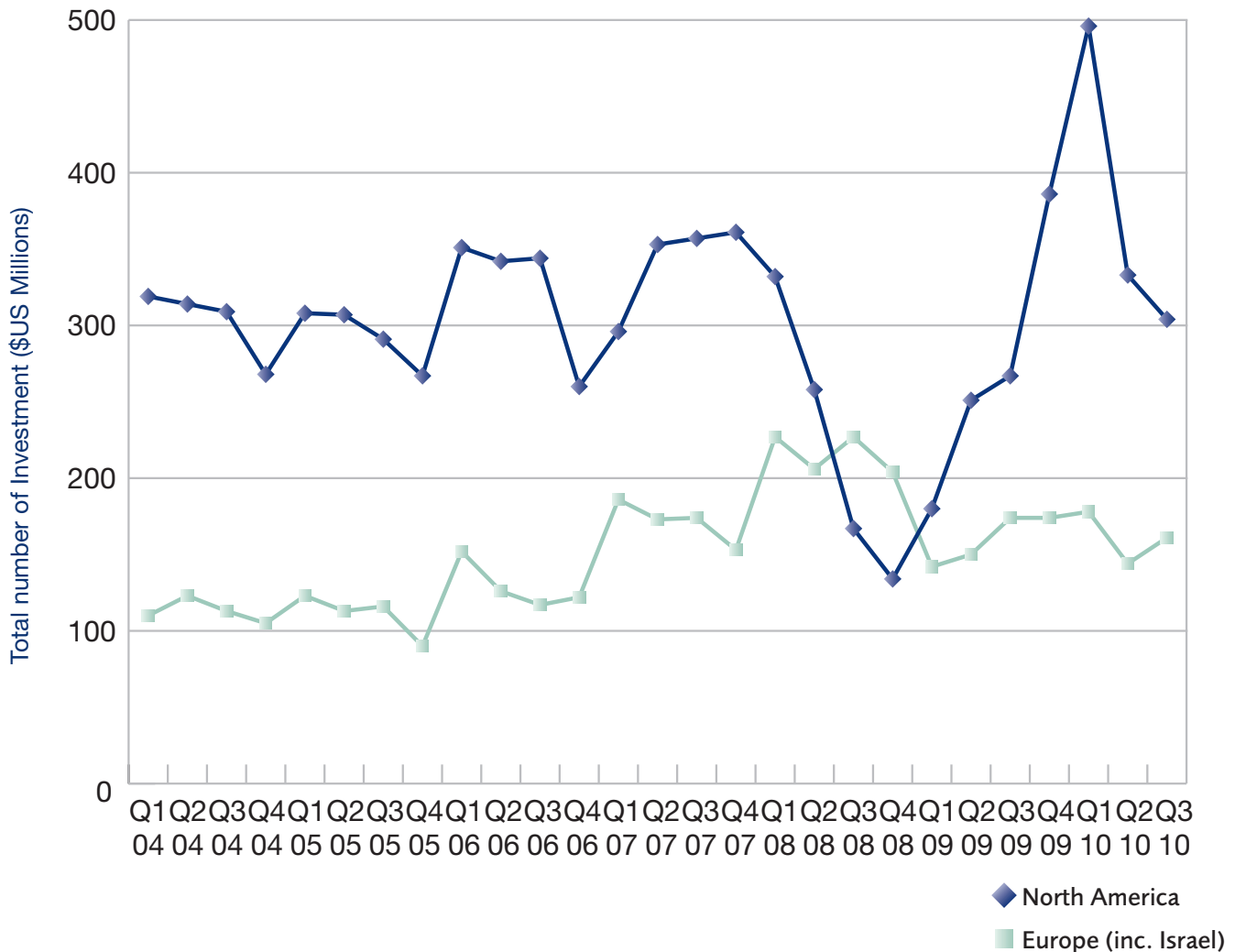

While the majority of Europe has seen a year on year decrease in the number of investments made, the UK has bucked that trend somewhat with a small but important return towards the level of investment seen at the beginning of the year. Given the understandable concern around AIFMD, this is an important time for investment within Europe.

Quantity of investment in the US has fallen by 39% since the start of the year. However, Q1 2010 marked a high point in investments since the Index began in 2004 and, as such, is perhaps an unfair comparison. Analysis of the year on year figures indicates growth of 14%.

Solera Networks is a Utah-based network forensics organisation whose software provides high speed forensics solutions to organisations in order to monitor happenings across its data networks. When confronted with a data attack, it allows a firm to identify where the attack is coming from and try to prevent the network from being compromised further. This Series C funding round takes the investments in Solera to approximately \$30.9million.

Touted by many as the iPad's killer app, Flipboard is essentially a content aggregator deriving its content from the updates of connections on the likes of Twitter and Facebook. Lending itself to a tablet devices form factor, the content is then flipped through in the same way as a conventional magazine. However this magazine is "edited" by one's friends and colleagues providing the all important social element. Many commentators suggest that tablet PCs will herald the end of the print medium and Flipboard may be viewed as a final nail in that coffin.

A firm that needs no introduction, Zynga has announced a further \$150million investment to bring Zynga's total funding to a rumoured \$519million. This round of investment, from Japanese internet firm Softbank, will seemingly aid the move into the gigantic Japanese games market and help Zynga hit its projected revenue of \$1billion by 2011.

Chegg, a well thought out combination of chicken and egg, offers online textbook rental to students in over 6,400 universities across North America. Textbook rental is a capital intensive market and the new investment, from Hong Kong investment firm Ace Limited, will help to scale up the warehouses, inventory, logistics and shipping that are vital to the business. Chegg launched in 2007 and has most recently acquired start-up CourseRank which aims to assist students in choosing the right university course for them.

Customers can answer one another's questions and issues about a particular product or brand which allows crowdsourcing and thus provides the company with timely and relevant information. The latest Series A financing takes total investment to \$10million.

Avast produce security software for the consumer and business markets. The product is free to download, and has been done so by 100million users, but subsequent upgrades are then charged for. This model has led to an estimated market share of 19.14%, the leader by some 7.75%, and to the company asserting that Avast software currently protects 1 out of 5 computers worldwide from malware.

Founded in Helsinki in 2006, Blyk is an advertising funded mobile network targeted at 16-24 year olds. Users are given free texts and minutes in exchange for agreeing to receive targeted advertisements from the likes of Coca Cola and L'Oreal. The latest round takes investments to around €87million and is, according to Blyk, one of the largest single rounds led by a Nordic investor in the tech space since 2005. The investment will be utilised to grow strategic partnerships with worldwide mobile operators.

Mywardrobe.com is positioned as an online retailer of affordable designer fashion from leading designer brands, the difference being that all items are from the brands' current season. Kooaba's mobile phone application allows users to take pictures of physical content such as dvd covers or film posters in order to derive information including pricing and special offers. As the company is about to deliver its Shooting Star app, the firms' CEO announced their intention to use the investment to expand the development team, enter new global markets and build its portfolio of partnerships with other players in their space.
