As the US and Eurozone governments continue to wrestle with some of the biggest economic challenges faced in modern times, Q2 2011 has been a bumper quarter all round in the world of tech investment. I have always maintained that this market is somewhat countercyclical, and this seems truer today than ever before.

In Europe there has been an enormous turnaround in activity and we have had the biggest quarter in terms of amount of VC investment in tech since we started the Index way back in 2003 – nearly \$1.3bn. Europe has never before had this many high-growth companies closing investment at this scale. Bigpoint leads the way with a \$350m round, Spotify closed \$100m and rounds in excess of \$20m were closed by; Enecsys, Shazam, Next Performance, Mediastay, Wimdu, Wooga, KupiVIP in Russia and Siano in Israel. One swallow does not make a summer but in relative terms this is an astonishing picture. In Europe we have eaten our fair share of humble-pie over the years and there has been plenty of VC-bashing and soul-searching on why US companies are so much more successful than their European counterparts. In Europe the baseline is lower but there is a groundswell of optimism and confidence out there. I loved reading about Heiko Hubertz, CEO of Bigpoint, in an article published recently where he described how he had declined the opportunity to cash out in their massive investment round as he felt that there was a clear opportunity to become a \$multi-billion company. With that attitude and commitment, you wouldn't bet against him.

On the subject of betting, as I write this, one of the poster children of the European tech scene, and a company we have enjoyed a very long and successful association with; Betfair, is trading at around 50% of its IPO price. There are some regulatory issues that give some cause for concern, but this is a high-growth business that has developed unique technology that has disintermediated a major market. If they were a NASDAQ company today, what would their market cap be? Food for thought. Things are improving in Europe but we still have some way to go.

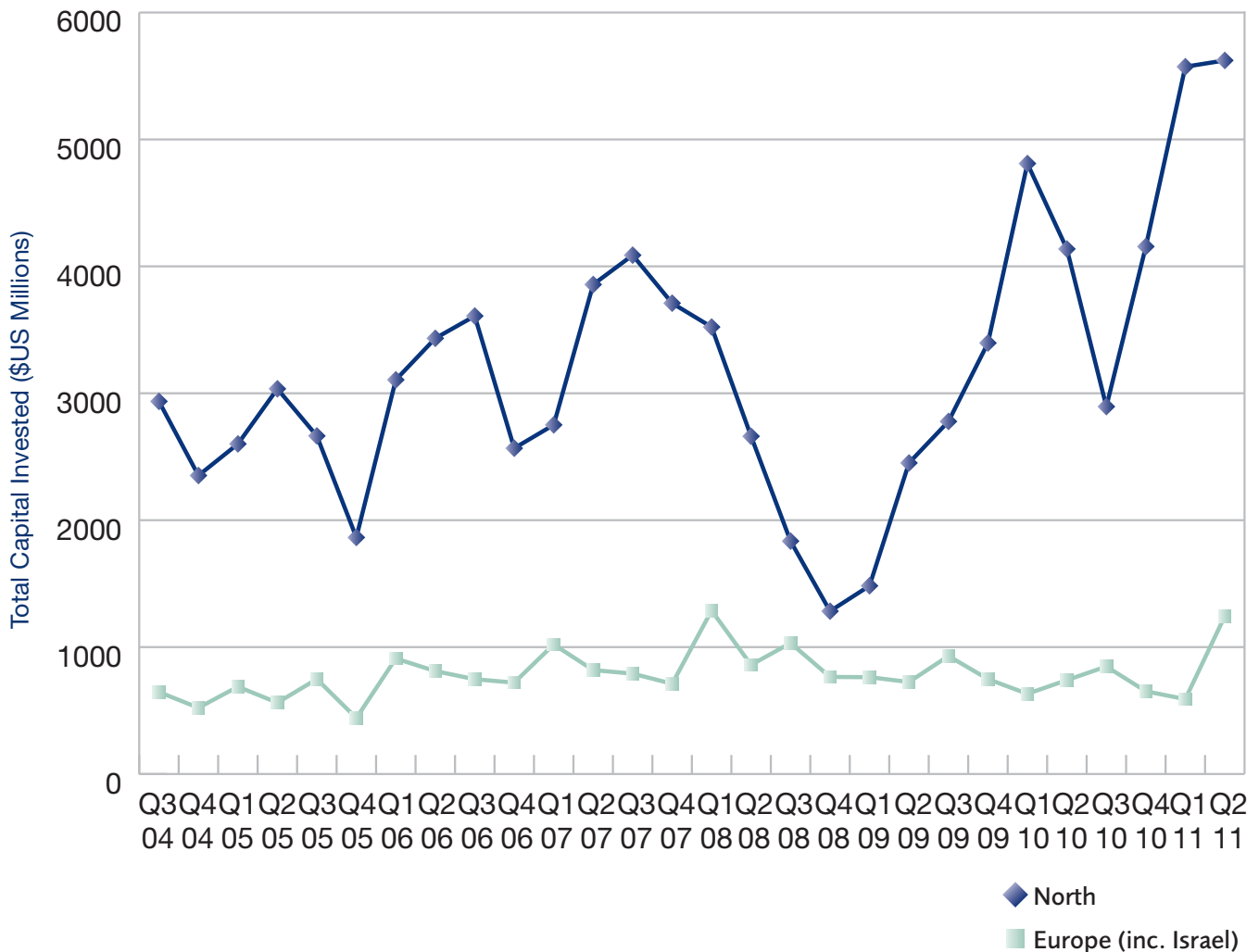

The US remains very active this quarter with \$5.64bn of investment – around the same level as last quarter and the Valley remains extremely busy. It is Europe where the notable difference in activity lies - \$1.29bn of tech investment closed. This is a massive number in European terms, and it is good to see that a number of European companies are starting to have global ambition and success with and as a result are closing big rounds of expansion capital rather than selling out to their US competitors.

It is good also to see a big rise in activity across the whole of Europe with substantial rises in activity in the UK, France and Germany. Israel and Ireland also got in on the act, both up over 100% on the previous quarter.

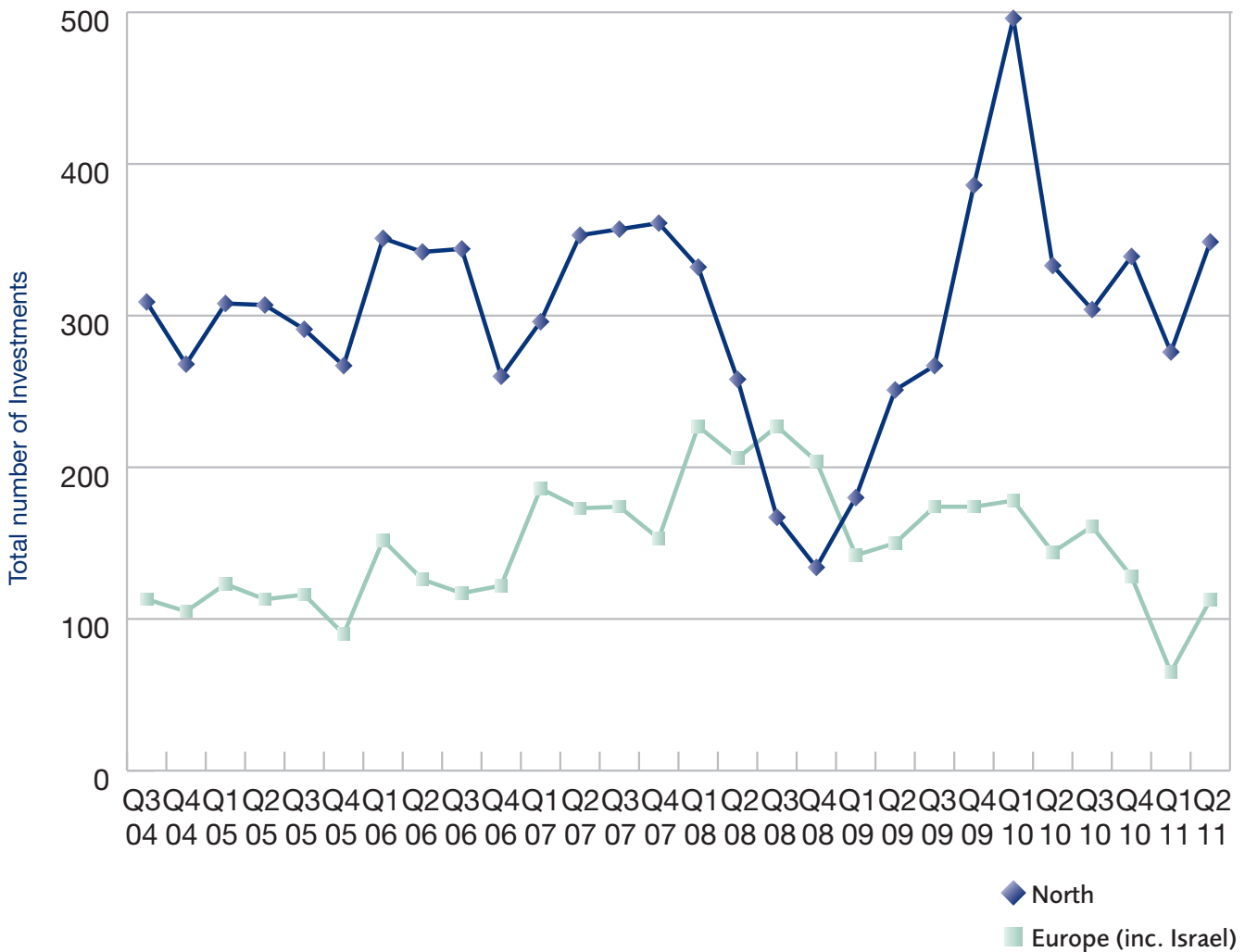

It's good to see that the big drop in the number of investments made in Q1 seems to have been a temporary situation with the number of investments returning to more normal levels this quarter. It is essential for the prosperity of the ecosystem that A and B rounds continue to be made in significant number, rather than investment dollars following later-stage and safer growth investments.

We have seen a real increase in demand for our services across Europe, in particular in France and Germany where a new breed of companies have their sights set on global success and they have the confidence to invest in bringing in Executive talent to help them compete, and win, on the global stage.

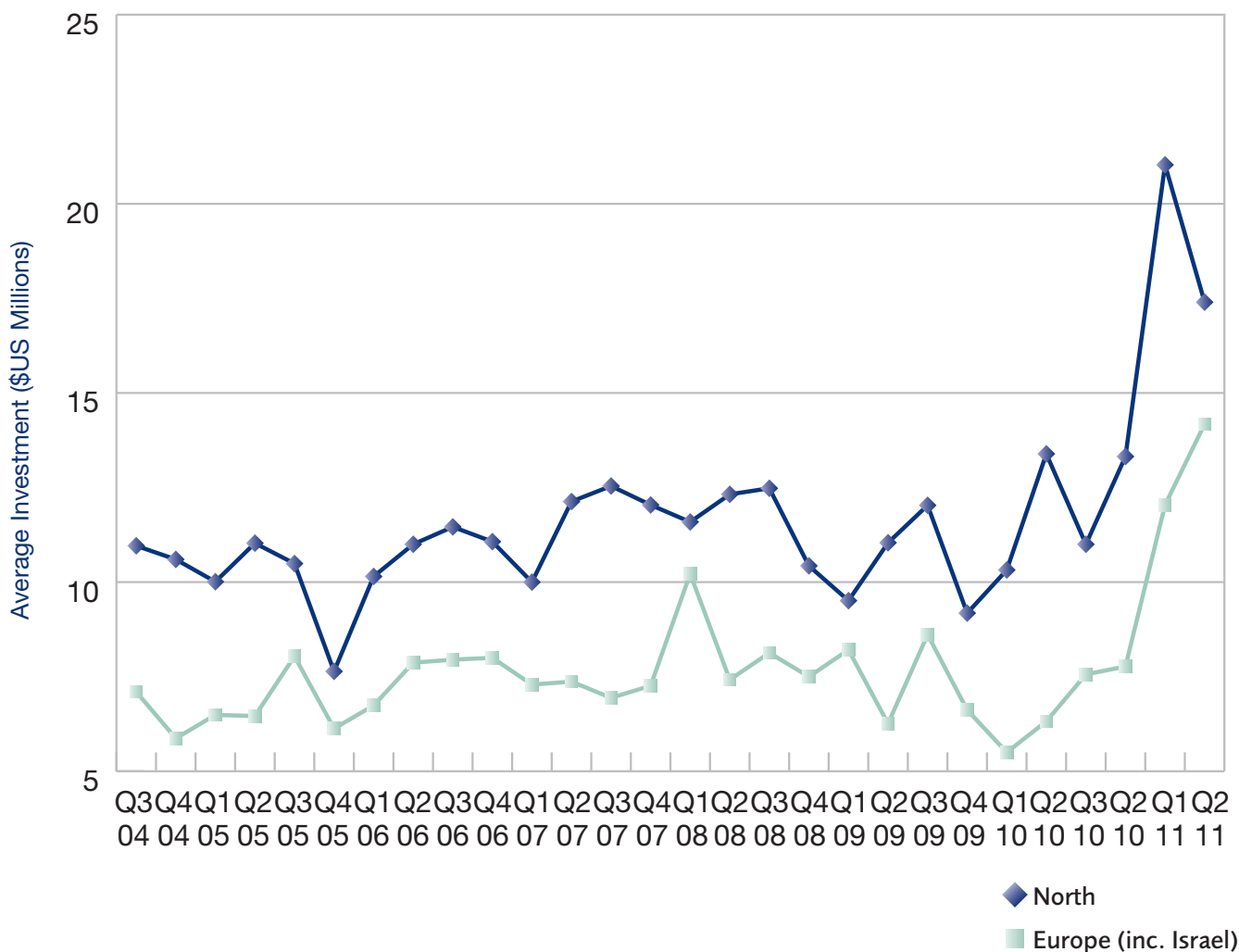

The average investment size remains high across all regions with a number of very significant rounds being closed by some later stage companies such as Facebook, Living Social and Brightsource in the US and Bigpoint and Spotify in Europe. These big investments lifted the regional average but it's good to see that most of the major markets in Europe saw a big rise in average investment size.

I always think that this is one of the most telling statistics in the Index, giving probably the best indication of confidence in the sector. It's great to see that it looks like we are on an upwards curve here. It is essential that companies in Europe stay the course and bring some stellar returns to their investors rather than play the percentages and sell out early.
